under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 :

Fireview Woodstove - Model 205
Keystone Woodstove - Model 204
Palladian Woodstove - Model 202
Classic Woodstove - Model 200

The wood stoves listed above each have thermal efficiency greater than 75% and satisfy the IRS requirements to be considered "qualified energy property" under Section 25C of the Internal Revenue Code. These stoves qualify for tax credits for their purchase and installation labor costs under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009.

The stove must be installed in an existing primary residence and purchased during 2009 or 2010 to be eligible for the tax credit. The credit applies to 30% of the purchase and installation labor costs up to a maximum of \$1,500 per homeowner. Consumers must keep a copy of this certificate with their tax records but do not need to submit it to the IRS with their tax returns.

Please note: The \$1,500 maximum credit applies to 30% of the sum of all IRS qualified improvements (such as insulation, energy saving windows and doors, etc.) made by a homeowner during 2009 and 2010. For further information, consult your tax advisor or visit www.energystar.gov
